

# Reflections of Compsci 101

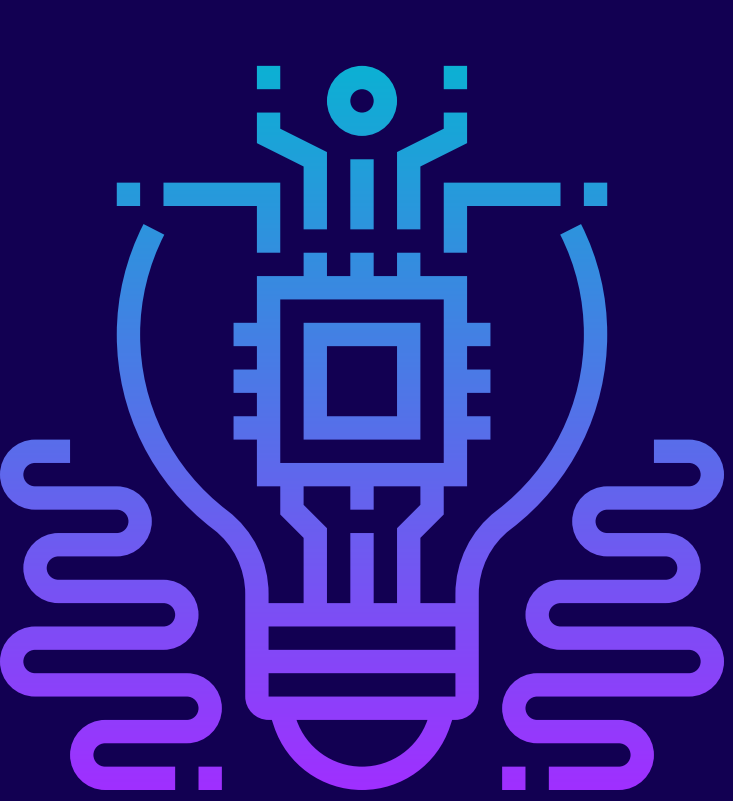
When I started this class,
